

# Lesson plan 1

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Now that you have signed up for Solfeg.io let's get started! One of the easiest ways to get students excited about using Solfeg.io is to start singing songs they enjoy so let's choose a song with your class.

**GOAL** Explore Solfeg.io, start singing, assign homework tasks.

## EXPLORE

Explore the library of songs and see what will best suit your classroom needs. Rock, pop, folk? Find out what your students like, you'll definitely find something that will spark their interest! Choose a song, press play! 10 min.

## LISTENING/SPEAKING/SINGING

First, try and find a song that everyone is somewhat familiar with, this makes the first process much smoother! Listen to the song as a class and have your students come up with one thing about the lyrics that speaks to them, or that they like. Practice first by speaking the lyrics in rhythm. Then sing with the provided vocal track, and then try it with instruments only! 20-25 min.

## DIVIDE THE INSTRUMENTS

Now you can divide up some of the instruments among your students so you can start playing in your next lesson. In Solfeg.io you can see chords for guitar, ukulele, bass, and piano! You'll also need some rhythm players, so maybe some nice hand drums, drumset, shakers or claves! 15 min.

## AFTER THE LESSON

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Find the Teacher's Dashboard link at the bottom of the screen and use the link provided and send to your students. Once they've clicked the link they've got access to the music library.

Homework - Solfeg.io can be accessed from anywhere! So we have provided homework handouts for your students to practice outside of the classroom.
