

Lesson plan 2

It's your 2nd week with Solfeg.io and now it's time to dig in! With this week's lesson, let's help your students to start playing music on their own. Here's a simple lesson idea to use!

GOAL Playing instruments in groups, learn basic chords and rhythms, inspire group

CREATE INSTRUMENT GROUPS

At the end of last week's lesson you divided the roles for the different instruments in your classroom. Now it's time to start playing them. Divide the students in groups organized by instrument. Choose a song with some easy chords to speed up the process. The students can use Solfeg.io online, or the pdf resources to assist in their learning. Each group can have a group leader, one student keeping the group focused on learning together. 25mins.

PLAYING TOGETHER

Now that your groups have become more familiar with the chords and rhythms they will be playing, each group can start to play their section together. If you are limited in classroom space, have the groups "show off" what they have learned for the other groups! At the end of the lesson, if possible, put 2-3 parts together. Spend the last few minutes reflecting on what chords/rhythms were learned. 25mins.

AFTER THE LESSON

After the lesson, remind students to sign up for Solfeg.io if they haven't already. Don't forget to stress the importance of practicing at home and to use the pdf resources provided by Solfeg.io!

It can be a challenge to get students to play together, so you can definitely use this lesson more than once! Solfeg.io makes it easy for you to get creative with your teaching, have fun yourself, and the students will follow!
