

Lesson plan 4

Welcome to week 4 using Solfeg.io. Here are some final tips for your trial period and in this lesson we'll aim for performance! As teachers, the ultimate goal is having your students perform. With Solfeg.io we want to make it easy and meaningful. Use the different instrument tracks to either support your students, or take away parts completely so that your students can shine!

GOAL Performance, student success

START THE LESSON BY HAVING A DISCUSSION

You can use these questions as a starting point!

- Did you practice your part before class?
- What is performance?
- What makes it worth watching or listening to?
- What should I think about during my performance?
- Should I listen to other instruments or just focus on my part?

DRESS REHEARSAL

Split your students into their instrument groups and treat your first few run throughs as a performance. After each run through give and ask for feedback.

- Were the chords, rhythms, and lyrics performed correctly?
- What worked well and what did not?
- How can we improve the sound or play better together?
- Are we ready to start using dynamics to make the music more exciting?
- Run a final dress rehearsal before recording a performance.

PERFORM

Now it's time for the first performance using Solfeg.io!

- Both audio and video recording work well for going back and reflecting on performances and to find areas for improvement. A simple video recorded with your phone can bring lots of positive emotions to your students' families, and will also strengthen your bond with parents as a teacher.
